Other board members asked about his plan for car sales, parking of cars on the property, proposed sign to advertise his business, privacy fencing, letter of intent from those who will pick up old tires and waste oil, and bonding—for failure to comply issues.

It was determined that the issuance of a Special Use Permit would again be tabled. Jim Welch, Dave Nussbaumer and Bob Grier will meet with Dan Gottermeier before the next board meeting on January 29 to go over each issue and to come to some sort of agreement. This will allow the board to review the conditions before the final vote.

Ken Miller made the motion to table the issue to review the conditions, bond and deposit by January 29.
