FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Town Board of the Town of Palmyra, will meet and review said preliminary budget and hold a Public Hearing thereon at the Palmyra Town Hall, 1180 Canandaigua Road, Palmyra, NY, at 7:00 PM on the 5th day of November, 2020. At this hearing any persons may be heard in favor of or against the Preliminary Budget as compiled, or for or against any item or items therein contained.

He stated that the snowmobile club insurance would cover liability (he will get that in writing), and its use up to Whitbeck Rd will only be available while the bridge is closed. Any abuse will end this opportunity for snowmobilers. Again, as discussed at previous meeting, this is something that the state will need to approve before use.

Supervisor Miller also reported that he had met with our Wayne County EMS Representative and the Director of Fingerlakes Ambulance to discuss the service Palmyra has been receiving as well as EMS in the county. FLA has recently hired ten addition staff, and it seems they are definitely focusing on Palmyra.
