TOWN BOARD FINAL ORDER
ESTABLISHING THE DISTRICT

The Town Board of the Town of Palmyra, Wayne County, New York, has caused a general map, plan and report to be prepared and filed in the Office of the Town Clerk of thTown in relation to the proposed establishment of a Water District or Extension thereto in the Town to be known as Extension No. 3 to the Central Water District of the Town of Palmyra.

On January 19, 1998, an Order was adopted by this Board reciting a description of the boundaries of the District, the proposed improvements, the maximum amount proposed to be expended for the improvements, the fact that the map, plan and report had b presented to the Board and were on file in the Town Clerk's Office, and specifying February 12, 1998 at 8:00 PM in the Town Clerk's Office of the Town of Palmyra, New York, as the time when and place where the Town Board would meet in a Public Hearing to hear all persons interested in the creation of the District, and for any other action on the part of the Town Board concerning the proposed district as might be required by law.

The Order was published and posted in the manner and within the time prescribed by Town Law Section 209-d, and proof of the publication and posting has been presented to the Town Board.

The Public Hearing was held at the time and place set forth in the Order and all persons desiring to be heard were heard.

Following the public hearing and based upon the evidence presented at the hearing, the Town Board, on

February 12, 1998, adopted a resolution subject to permissive referendum determining in the affirmative all of the questions set forth in Town Law Sec. 209-e (1) and approving the establishment of the District.

Notice of the adoption of the Resolution was published and posted in the manner required by law and proof of the publication and posting has been presented to the Town Board.

The permission of the State Comptroller for the establishment of the District was not necessary as there is no indebtedness.

It is hereby Ordered as follows:

1. Extension No. 3 to the Central Water District of the Town of Palmyra, Wayne County, New York, is hereby established substantially in accordance with the above map, plan and resort and the District shall be bounded and described as follows:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, situate on the north side of North Creek Road in the Town of Palmyra, County of Wayne and State of New York, bounded and described as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the north line of the Central Water District with the east line of premises now owned by Daniel Pedtke and Mary Bolton, bearing tax account no. 33111-00-556901; thence 1) northerly along the east line of said parcel to the northeast corner of said parcel; thence 2) westerly along the north line of said parcel and parcel with tax map no. 33111-00-501913 and parcel with tax map no, 33111-0 0-446363, to the northwest corner of said parcel bearing tax map no. 33111-00-446963; thence 3) southerly along the west line of the last aforesaid tax parcel to its intersection with the north line of the Central Water District; thence 4) easterly along the north line of the Central water District to the point and Qlace of beginning.

- 2. The construction of the proposed improvements for the district, consisting of a water system, including water mains, distribution pipes, hydrants, reservoirs, and including a proposed plan of purchase of water from the Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, and including the purchase of the assets, if any, which presently operates a water system within a portion of the proposed district, and also including land or rights in land, original furnishing, equipment, machinery or apparatus incidental thereto, substantially as set forth on the map, plan and report to, it hereby authorized as a maximum estimated cost of \$0.
- 3. The improvements servicing the area having been installed by the Central Water District, the properties in Extension No. 3 of the Central Water District shall pay any charges with the same ad valorem rates as in the Central Water District, together with the same fees for connection, hookup, use of water and maintenance of the system.

The Town tierk is hereby uthorized and directed to cause a certifid copy of this Order to be recorded and filed in aclcordahce with the provisions of Town Law $S\ d.\ 209-9$ (1) .
