The Town Board of Palmyra designates the Wayne County Cable TV Council to coordinate administration of the franchise agreement with the other participating towns and villages of Wayne County;

The Town Board of Palmyra shall appoint a representative to the council who is authoriz3ed to vote on its behalf on matters of franchise administration and administration and operations of Public, Educational, and Governmental Access.

The Town Board of Palmyra understand that funding for the administration and operations of Public, Educational, and Governmental Access is not yet determined and that the council will seek funding sources that may include but are not limited to: School districts, franchise fees paid to the Towns and Villages, the Wayne County Board of Supervisors, grants, and public fund raising.
